ELIGIBILITY

Youth who are between the ages of 13-18 and reside in Yolo County are welcome to apply. At the time of appointment in January 2024, youth commissioners shall be no younger than 13 and no older than 18 years of age. The Youth Commission consists of 15 members appointed to a one-year term. Commissioners may be appointed to an additional one-year term.
