The completed original guest pass application must be shown at the time of bid purchase by the student. The original guest pass application will be kept by DSHS staff for use at check-in at the Dance. A photocopy of guest photo ID must be attached. Any high school student from a school outside of DJUSD must turn in an approved guest pass in order to buy a ticket. A new pass must be submitted for every dance.

The guest listed on this pass may be denied if the the quest has ever had an Expulsion from any school, severe or multiple discipline history, or recent behavioral problems.

Guests may not be older than 20 years or age or below the 10th grade. Non-students who attend a DSHS dance are expected to adhere to the DSHS policies for conduct.

Davis Joint Unified School District regulations expect student dress and grooming to be appropriate for a positive educational environment; dress and personal hygiene that could be considered distracting, derogatory, offensive, intimidating, or interfering with the educational process is prohibited. If a student is found in violation of the dance dress code, they will not be allowed into the dance until the student has changed into suitable attire.

**Apparel should:**

Cover front and back, top and bottom; no low cut necklines, strapless, backless, bikini, tubetop, spaghetti straps, halter or single strap shirts, no loose arm-hole shirts/tans, etc. No undergarments showing (i.e. Underwear, bras, bra straps, thongs. No exposed midriff. Skirts and shorts should be modest and cover the student's bottom.

They should also:

Be free of any image or depiction of drugs, alcohol, sex, tobacco, and/or anything illegal.

Be free of any image or depiction associated or affiliated with gang activity.

Be safe in, and not distracting to the environment.

Because our dances are held in our basketball courts, shoes must be soft-soled. No hard-soled shoes will be allowed. Shoes should not "clack" on a hard surface.

**Dress/Physical Appearance**

Students in violation may be asked to make corrections such as the following:

Turn shirt inside out, Put on a sweater/coat, Cover up exposed area, Call home for a change of clothes

**Junior Prom and Senior Ball Dress Code**

The Junior Prom and Senior Ball are formal dances. Please dress appropriately. Keep in mind that all attire-related concerns will be addressed by administration accordingly. Sexually explicit dancing and exhibitionism-including overt and explicit sexual behavior – may result in your being asked to leave the dance.

- Strapless and spaghetti straps are allowed
- Shirts must remain on.
- Shorts and skirts can be no shorter than fingertip length (subject to administrator's discretion)
- All undergarments must be covered at all times.
- No images or depictions of drugs, alcohol, sex, tobacco and/or illegal activity.

**Dancing Guidelines**

- No straddling legs or explicitly sexual behavior; No overt/prolonged PDA.; Must keep at least one foot on floor at all times.

**Liability:** Please note that for the Senior Ball, no DJUSD student, or their guest, is permitted to have a previous/current room reservation to use the hotel rooms at the Hyatt Regency Hotel or surrounding hotels. If a student occupies a room, all damage caused to any material/item, room, or person will be directly the legal responsibility of the occupant (i.e. student) to reimburse the hotel, (per Hyatt Regency Management). The use of the hotel room is considered leaving the event, and the students will not be allowed re-entry to the dance.

**DJUSD Yearlong Dance Contract**

Every participant of a DJUSD dance must have a contract on file. Turn this into the DSHS Finance Office.

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The expectations for behavior that are listed below are consistent with those that exist when a student is in class or at a school activity. Individuals who are unable, or unwilling, to behave within these expectations are advised not to attend in the dance, students on the No Activities List are not allowed to attend the dance.

**WARNING: STROBE LIGHTS MAYBE USED THROUGHOUT THE EVENING**

- You must provide a current school ID at time of the ticket purchase. Sales of ticket are final – no refunds will be given. Students are required to school a school ID to enter the dance.
- No students will be admitted into the dance after 10:00 p.m. (8:30 for the Senior Ball, as meal is served).
- Once you have entered the dance, if you decide to leave or have been asked to leave, you will **not be allowed** to re-enter; are no refund of admission will be given.
- No backpacks or bags will be allowed. Students are subject to search by security at the door.
- All students must be willing to submit to a search for alcohol, drugs, or tobacco products should administration think necessary.
- If a student becomes involved in one of the following situations, disciplinary consequences will be administered according to the California Education Code and parents will be notified:
  - o Harassing behaviors directed at any student, teacher, parent, or any other person(s)
  - o Fighting, or the physical assault of another person(s)
  - o Possession, use, or sale of weapons, drugs, or alcohol
- § Students who appear to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be tested, and if under the influence will be suspended from school. (Note: police will be notified)
- o Student wearing clothing that is in violation of the school dress code policy
- o Sexual dancing, exhibitionism, and all including overt and explicit sexual behavior
